DELPHIS ACQUIRES SJURSOYA CONTAINER TERMINAL (OSLO)

On the 27th of October 2009, Delphis has acquired the container terminal activities of Norsteve Oslo (part of Finnlines Group) in Oslo, Norway. Newly founded Sjursoya Container Terminal A/S (SCT) – a 100 % Delphis subsidiary – will be the operating company.

Strategically located on the Sjursoya peninsula in the heart of the port of Oslo, SCT is Norway's most modern container terminal and a gateway to the country's 4.8 million consumers.

SCT's has the capacity to handle 143,000 TEU, and offers unique off-dock facilities located within the terminal boundaries.

Alexander Saverys, Managing Director of Delphis commented : "With the acquisition of SCT we will be able to offer first class container handling services in a country where we are already very well established. We look forward to develop and grow the business in close co-operation with the port of Oslo and all its stakeholders."

Delphis' other activities in Norway include Team Lines Norge A/S (feeder and door-door logistics agency) and Team Lines' weekly connecting services between the Oslo fjord ports (Oslo, Brevik, Kristiansand, Larvik and Moss) and Europe's major container hub ports.
